The City of Holyoke, lead city for Holyoke-Chicopee-Westfield Consortium, has issued the draft FY2021 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan on the Consortium's anticipated uses of HOME-ARP funds. The Consortium includes the cities of Holyoke, Chicopee and Westfield and has been awarded \$3,329,224.00 in HOME-ARP funds.

HOME-ARP funds may be used benefit qualifying populations through:

1. Tenant-based Rental Assistance (TBRA);
2. Development and support of affordable housing;
3. Provision of supportive services;
4. Acquisition and development of non-congregate shelter;
5. Nonprofit capacity building and operating assistance; and
6. Funds for the planning and administration of the HOME-ARP Program.

For the purposes of HOME-ARP, the American Rescue Plan Act (ARP) defines qualifying individuals or families, including Veterans, that are:

1. Homeless, as defined in section 103(a) of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act;
2. At risk of homelessness, as defined in section 401 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act;
3. Fleeing or attempting to flee domestic violence, dating violence, sexual assault, or stalking (as defined by HUD in 24 CFR 5.2003) or human trafficking (as outlined in the Trafficking Victims Protection Act of 2000 as amended [22 USC 7102]); and
4. Part of other populations, where providing supportive services or assistance under section 212(a) of the National Affordable Housing Act 42 USC 12472(a) would: a. Prevent a family's homelessness; b. Serve those with the greatest risk of housing instability.

The draft FY2021 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan is available for a fifteen-day public comment period starting on February 6, 2023. Comments may be submitted to one of the offices below until 4:00 p.m. EST on February 23, 2023. The FY2021 HOME-ARP Allocation Plan will be submitted to HUD after a review of public comments, on or about February 24, 2023. Comments will be accepted by the community development offices in each community: in person by appointment, by mail, email, hand delivery or by calling and speaking with a staff member. This draft is a revised edition of a previously published HOME-ARP Allocation Plan.

The draft can be viewed at webpage of each city or in-person by appointment at the addresses below. Upon request, a PDF version will be emailed. Additional information can be obtained from the respective city's community development office.

The American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 appropriated \$5 billion to provide housing, services, and shelter to individuals experiencing homelessness and other vulnerable populations through the HOME-ARP Program. Funds were allocated by formula to jurisdictions that qualify for funding through the HOME Investment Partnership Program from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). The Holyoke-Chicopee Westfield HOME Consortium will receive \$3,329,224. Westfield will receive approximately \$502,712 in HOME-ARP funds. When the City proposes an Allocation Plan, Annual Action Plan, or an Amendment, it is required to follow a Citizen Participation Plan, which provides citizens with an opportunity to review and comment on said amendments.

Thus, the City of Westfield, through the Holyoke-Chicopee-Westfield HOME Consortium, is proposing a HOME-ARP Allocation plan, which details the Consortium's plan to distribute HOME-ARP funds on eligible projects and activities. The Allocation Plan is available for review and comment from February 6, 2023 through February 23, 2023 at the Community Development Department, 59 Court Street, Westfield, MA or online at www.cityofwestfield.org.

In accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan, a Public Hearing will be held on **Wednesday, February 15, 2023, at 5:00 pm**, at Westfield City Hall, 59 Court Street, Room 315, Westfield, Massachusetts 01085.

La Ley del Plan de Rescate Estadounidense de 2021 asignó \$ 5 mil millones para proporcionar vivienda, servicios y refugio a personas sin hogar y otras poblaciones vulnerables a través del Programa HOME-ARP. Los fondos se asignaron por fórmula a las jurisdicciones que califican para la financiación a través del Programa de Asociación de Inversión HOME del Departamento de Vivienda y Desarrollo Urbano de EE. UU. (HUD). El consorcio HOME de Holyoke-Chicopee Westfield recibirá \$3,329,224. Westfield recibirá aproximadamente \$502,712 en fondos HOME-ARP. Cuando la Ciudad propone un Plan de Asignación, un Plan de Acción Anual o una Enmienda, se requiere seguir un Plan de Participación Ciudadana, que brinda a los ciudadanos la oportunidad de revisar y comentar sobre dichas enmiendas.

Por lo tanto, la ciudad de Westfield, a través del Holyoke-Chicopee-Westfield HOME Consortium, propone un plan de asignación de HOME-ARP, que detalla el plan del Consortium para distribuir los fondos de HOME-ARP en proyectos y actividades elegibles. Закон об Американском плане спасения от 2021 года выделил 5 миллиардов долларов на предоставление жилья, услуг и убежища бездомным и другим уязвимым группам населения в рамках программы НОМЕ-АРР. Средства были выделены по формуле юрисдикциям, которые имеют право на финансирование в рамках Программы инвестиционного партнерства НОМЕ от Министерства жилищного строительства и городского развития США (HUD). Консорциум Holyoke-Chicopee Westfield НОМЕ получит 3 329 224 доллара. Westfield получит примерно 502 712 долларов в виде средств НОМЕ-АРР. Когда город предлагает план распределения, годовой план действий или поправку, он обязан следовать плану участия граждан, который дает гражданам возможность просматривать и комментировать указанные поправки.
