30-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Title I of the Cranston-Gonzalez National Affordable Housing Act requires that in order to apply for certain U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD) Programs, the City of Westfield must submit a Five-Year Consolidated Plan and Annual Action Plans. Further, when the City proposes to amend a Consolidated Plan or Annual Action Plan, it is required to follow a Citizen Participation Plan, which provides citizens with an opportunity to review and comment on said amendments.

The City of Westfield, MA, is a federal entitlement community that receives annual allocations of Community Development Block Grant funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).

The City is proposing amendments to the 2020-2024 Consolidated Plan, the 2020 Annual Action Plan, the 2021 Annual Action Plan, and the 2022 Annual Action Plan. All amendments are available for review and comments at the Community Development Department, 59 Court Street, Westfield, MA or online at www.cityofwestfield.org.

In accordance with the City's Citizen Participation Plan, a Public Hearing will be held on **Wednesday, August 10, 2022, at 5:00 pm**, at Westfield City Hall, 59 Court Street, Room 201, Westfield, Massachusetts 01085.
