City Soliciting 2019 Projects to Assist Low and Moderate Income Neighborhoods & Households

The Office of Community Development and Planning will conduct two public hearings on **Tuesday, January 15, 2019, at 11:00 am and 6:00 pm** to discuss community development needs and priorities for U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) funds for the Fifth Year Action Plan Fiscal Year 2019.

The hearings will take place in City Hall, Room 315, 59 Court Street, Westfield.

The City of Westfield Office of Community Development and Planning will utilize the information from the public hearing to make funding decisions for the federal Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG). Applications for the funding under this program are available beginning on Monday, at the Office of Community Development and Planning, City Hall, 3rd floor, during normal business hours.

FFY 2019 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) proposal applications for funding of activities in the City of Westfield to benefit low and moderate income persons or low and moderate income areas in the City will be available beginning on Thursday, December 20, 2018. Eligible activity categories include Public Services, Public Facilities, Housing, Public Infrastructure, and Economic Development.

Agencies and organizations seeking CDBG funding for activities must call or email the Office of Community Development to request instructions and an application.

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All CDBG applications are due by Friday, March 11, 2019 at 4:00 pm.

FFY 2019 funding will be for activities undertaken from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The City of Westfield CDBG Allocations have not yet been determined by HUD, but the City anticipates a CDBG allocation of \$350,000.
